Because students within the AISD need more help with their SAT scores, LNESC pays for a free SAT workshop that covers the English and Math component of the SAT during a two-week period. LNESC hires private tutors to go over material that is seen habitually on the SAT. Many of the questions on the test are types of questions seen on STARR testing and tests taken throughout a student's academic career from 8th-11th grade. LNESC conducts this workshop every summer, so if you are interested in participating, please contact your local LNESC counselor.
