These model programs are designed to help the organization reach its mission of providing the highest quality educational programs needed to help members of the Hispanic community become life-long learners and leaders.

Program Summary and Key Duties

LULAC National Educational Service Centers (LNESC) seeks part-time, grant-funded tutors to work with the LNESC Oxnard Project Director and Staff to provide academic support in the form of one-on-one or small group tutoring. youth for the academic challenges and rewards of pursuing and completing post-secondary programs.
